Special notice: Due to the fact that this first annual cycling event starts on the closed streets of Downtown Medford, the ride will **start promptly at 9:00 am** prior to the Pear Blossom Parade which starts at 11:00 am.

All distances will need to be on course between 9:00 am and 9:20 am. **Remember this is a ride not a race...**

City of Medford intersections will be closed and controlled by Motorcycle Officers and Pedals 'n Pears volunteers. Please be courteous! Once your ride is underway please keep moving until out of Medford City Limits (Approx. 3 miles - Kings Hwy.) If you miss the start you are not disqualified. Please follow the same route, however you will be required to obey all traffic controls. Please find map from check-in to start in this packet.

All riders must obey all traffic controls beginning at the intersection of Kings Hwy. and South Stage Road.

Rider Check-In Required

Early check in: (Pick up your swag bag, wrist band, t-shirt and maps - FREE bike safety check) Friday April 8th Marty's Cycles 712 Crater Lake Ave. Medford (Additional parking in the Cedar Mall - 820 Crater Lake Ave.) 4 pm - 8 pm.

Day of event check in:

Saturday April 9th Hawthorne Park at Main Street 7:30 am - 8:45 am

All distances will be fully supported and use the Bear Creek Greenway from US Cellular Park to Hawthorne Park for the finish. There are several parking lots in and around Medford's Hawthorne Park (see map). All parking is free on Saturdays.
